

CHANGES TO CAR PARKING FROM JANUARY 2008

Due to a new student residences project, the University car parks will be closed from January 2008. Please be advised that these works will not take place near, nor will they affect the Lakeside Centre and we will continue to deliver superior service in world class venues. There are pay & display car parks close to the venue as indicated on the additional leaflet, but we would highly recommend the use of public transport during this period. Information for which is provided below.

Overnight guests may park in Car Park 6 between the hours of 6pm and 9am but vehicles should be moved to an alternative car park by 9am to avoid parking fines that are beyond the control of Conference Aston. Please register your vehicle registration number with reception at Aston Business School Conference Centre if parking overnight.

Rail Links: New Street/Snow Hill/Moor Street train stations are all within 20 minutes walk of the venue or a 5 minute taxi ride. Please visit www.thetrainline.com to find appropriate routes into Birmingham.

Bus Routes: A number of bus services operate to the University Campus throughout the day. Please visit www.travelwm.co.uk/bus where a route planner is available.

ROAD DIRECTIONS

From M6 North and South

- Exit at Junction 6 and follow A38M towards City Centre.
- Take lane 2 of the A38M for almost 2 miles and take the 3rd exit off (at the 'end of motorway' sign before the flyover) and Aston University will be on your left hand side.
- Stay in the left-hand lane alongside the University and then at the round-about with the fire station on the left, take the 1st exit - follow directions below for day delegates and visitors.

From M42 East Midlands

From the M42 join the M6 northbound heading towards Birmingham Central. Leave the M6 at junction 6 and follow the directions from M6 North and South above.

From M5 South-West and City Centre

- Leave the M5 at Junction 3 and follow the A456 for about 5 miles towards the City Centre.
- As you approach the City, the road broadens to three lanes. Take the outside lane following signs for Convention Centre and Broad Street. Take the underpass into Broad Street.
- Drive all the way along Broad Street and follow the signs at the round-about for Inner Ring Road, North and M6, Lichfield A38. Take the 2nd exit from round-about following the same signs.
- Keep in the outside lane and take the underpass (St Chad's Circus Queensway) signed Lichfield A38.
- At the end of the underpass, exit left before the flyover.
- Go to the round-about and take the 3rd exit off past the Fire Station - follow directions below for delegates and visitors.

From M40 Oxford and the South

Take M40 northbound and join the M42 westbound towards the M5. Travel north on the M5, leaving at junction 3 and follow directions from M5 South-West above.

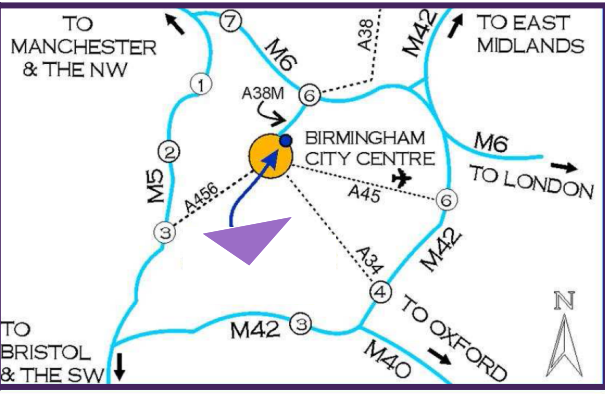

DIRECTIONS TO THE LAKESIDE CENTRE

Rail From any of the 3 main stations (New Street, Moor Street and Snow Hill), it is 5 minutes by taxi and 15 minutes by foot (routeways shown on map).

Buses leave Lower Bull Street (No.14) and Snow Hill Queensway (No.65 or 67) every 7 minutes - see both map and key for details.

Air From Birmingham International Airport, we are a 25 minute taxi journey. There are also trains every 15 minutes from the airport (Birmingham International) to New Street Station.
