Mott MacDonald is delighted to announce that it will continue to lead the **Project Support Unit (PSU)** for the Frameworks.

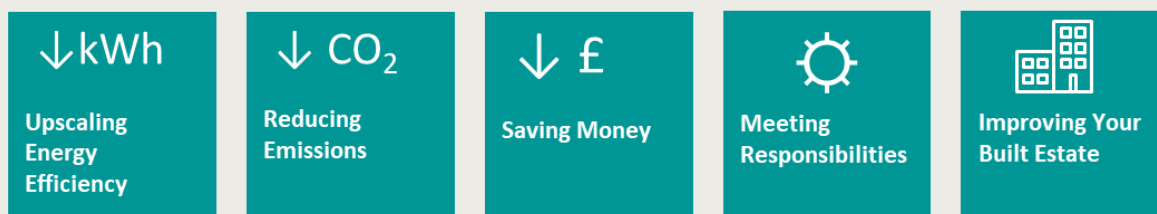
